

War at a Glance

NEW DELHI—India said her forces were pushing forward in East Pakistan at many points and turning back the Pakistanis in the West.

RAWALPINDI — Pakistan broke relations with India after Indian recognition of the rebel Bangla Desh regime.

WASHINGTON—The United States, which continued to brand India as the “main aggressor,” suspended a large part of its economic aid to the Indians.

UNITED NATIONS — The Security Council voted, 11-0, to transfer the debate on the Indian-Pakistani fighting to the veto-free General Assembly, after repeated vetoes by the Soviet Union of various resolutions in the Council.
